The Consortium was formed 13 years ago and is open to membership from village halls and similar buildings predominantly in the north of the county. Its purpose is to act in the interests of halls and promote their effectiveness and success. We now have about 70 members and meet every 4 months in different parts of the county and on different days of the week to make attendance easier. We invite outside speakers to every meeting.

- support to achieve a nationally recognised quality standard through the Village Hall Hallmark scheme – something likely to impress potential funders.
- substantial discounts on annual fire extinguisher servicing and replacement extinguishers.
